Addresses the changing needs of the Internet Society Chapters and reinforces the organisation's commitment to development.

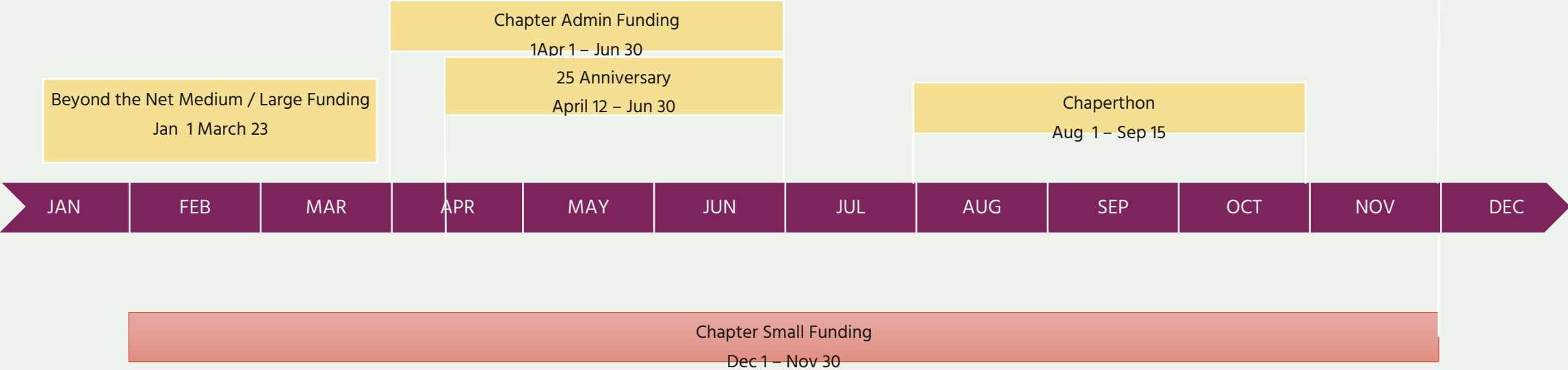

Following an extensive review, we will launch the refreshed Internet Hall of Fame in 2017 as part of ISOC@25.



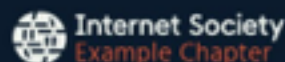
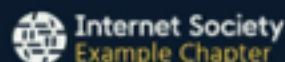
